Application	Provision (CrPC / BNSS)	Purpose / When Filed
Application for Anticipatory Bail	Sec. 438 CrPC → BNSS 482	To seek bail before arrest.
Application for Regular Bail	Sec. 437–439 CrPC → BNSS 478–480	To secure release after arrest.
Application for Default Bail	Sec. 167(2) CrPC → BNSS 187(3)	If charge sheet not filed within prescribed time (60/90 days).
Application for Cancellation of Bail	Sec. 439(2) CrPC → BNSS 480(2)	To cancel bail if accused misuses liberty.
Application for Exemption from Personal Appearance	Sec. 205 CrPC	To excuse accused from appearing in court personally.
Application for Discharge	Sec. 227 (Sessions), 239 (Magistrate) CrPC → BNSS 262–263	Filed before charge is framed to seek discharge.
Application for Quashing of FIR / Proceedings	Sec. 482 CrPC → BNSS 528	To quash FIR, charge sheet, or criminal proceedings.
Application for Compounding of Offence	Sec. 320 CrPC → BNSS 361	To compound offences with victim's consent.

Application	Provision (CrPC / BNSS)	Purpose / When Filed
Application for Plea Bargaining	Sec. 265A–L CrPC → BNSS 290–303	For settlement in less serious cases.
Application for Release of Property	Sec. 451/457 CrPC → BNSS 452–455	For custody/release of seized property or vehicle.
Application for Interim Custody of Vehicle	Sec. 451/457 CrPC	Common in motor vehicle seizure cases.
Application under Sec. 91 CrPC	Sec. 91 → BNSS 349	To summon documents or objects.
Application under Sec. 311 CrPC	Sec. 311 → BNSS 350	For recalling or summoning witnesses.
Application for Adjournment	Sec. 309 CrPC → BNSS 346	To seek time during trial.
Application for Transfer of Case	Sec. 406, 408, 410 CrPC → BNSS 410–415	To transfer case to another court.
Application for Restoration of Complaint	Sec. 256 CrPC	If case dismissed in default of complainant.
Application for Issuing Warrant/Summons	Sec. 204 CrPC	To request court to issue process against accused.

Application	Provision (CrPC / BNSS)	Purpose / When Filed
Application for Medical Examination of Victim/Accused	Sec. 53, 164A CrPC → BNSS 62, 185	To prove offence (rape, hurt, intoxication, etc.).
Application under Sec. 340 CrPC	Sec. 340 → BNSS 222	To prosecute for perjury/false evidence.
Application for Compensation to Victim	Sec. 357 CrPC → BNSS 399	For victim compensation from accused/fine.
Application for Probation	Probation of Offenders Act, 1958	For first-time offenders / minor crimes.
Application for Withdraw Case	Sec. 321 CrPC → BNSS 360	By Public Prosecutor with court permission.

Tip for Practice:

- Many of these applications are **standard formats** (Draft → Affidavit → Grounds → Prayer).
- Lawyers usually keep **precedent templates** ready (Bail, Discharge, 91/311, Quash).
- Courts expect **concise grounds + legal citations** (especially in bail/quash matters).
